#### PLANNING FOR PARENTHOOD

You are the best parents your child can have. You mean the world to them. Awareness is now increasing that skilfully parenting a growing child in today's rapidly changing world has become a priority. Many parents are heard to say that parenting the new generation has become an onerous task indeed.

Children now-a-days are moulded by peers and influenced by hi-tech gadgets of the digital decade and with higher IQs and smarter than ever before, need to be guided in the right direction to develop to their full inherent potential, living in the "space age, iphones and ipad new generation" with NASA announcing the

establishment of a permanent base on the moon, Mars etc with rockets and spacecrafts to get people there and all the amenities of life styles, we are accustomed to and with solar power generation of near



constant sunlight and the like. What was science fiction in the past is well on the way to becoming a reality in the very near future.

Today's parents are probably better at bringing up their children than any previous generation. They are more aware of the importance of the early childhood years and knowing this, are concerned about not making mistakes. However, the upbringing



of our children takes on the added dimension of living in a rapidly advancing scientific and technological world, with the additional stress of working parents and nuclear

families. Having a baby is one of God's choicest gifts to human beings and child rearing is a privilege. Children are our most prized possessions and each child is a unique individual.

#### GOALS OF NEW GEN PARENTING

The goal of New Gen Parenting is skilfully guiding a child right from birth through adolescence to mature adulthood in a way that each child reaches fulfilment as an individual, in keeping with his or her own natural abilities. This is the reason for planning parenthood. Couples, on the threshold of family life, have to make probably one of the most important decisions of their lives - whether to have children or

not. This requires a consideration of all the various factors involved. Parenting entails responsibility which lasts a lifetime and may prove to be the toughest job one has ever undertaken but it can also be the most satisfying.

Some couples, where both partners are career-oriented, opt not to have children. They are too busy pursuing their careers and have little or no time for child rearing. This is the double income, no children group (DINK). Then there are couples, both of whom are pursuing their careers, who decide to have one child, the double income, one kid (DIKO) group. The third group comprises those who decide on more than one child. One parent, usually the mother, opts out of a career, to raise her family. In some cases, the father is the stay-at-home parent: These are children of single income group (KIS).

Then there are the single parents, who have to work, where the child is left with a caretaker, usually a grandparent—the kid with the single income group (KISP). There is yet another group that of single parent with children who are generating a double income, being an entrepreneur as well as employed in a corporate company—these are single parent with double income and children (SPIKD).

All of these groups have one common issue: Children are expensive both in terms of money and personal effort: energy, lost career opportunities and sacrifice. After considering the costs and having made the decision to have children, let us review the advantages of Parenthood.

This little bundle, a genetic replica of parents evokes love, joy and happiness in us constantly bubbling forth like a spring in the sharing and caring, watching the child develop into a healthy, intelligent and compassionate person. This investment in the lives of children will reap rich dividends as that child grows into a stable, mature, responsible and happy adult, effectively parenting them requires skill.

Children develop in a sequential manner from infancy through childhood and adolescence to mature adulthood through ten distinct stages from birth to

maturity or adulthood between twenty and twenty five years. Parenting strategies varies from stage to stage and should be appropriate to that age and particular stage of development of a child, to make the task of parenting rewarding.

Understanding individual variations in the stages of development and knowing how each stage is manifested in a child's behaviour provides guidelines and tools for skilful parenting. As children grow the demands of each successive developmental stage is characterized by its own set of problems which must be overcome if they are to proceed with confidence to the next stage.

There are two main aspects in skilfully parenting



the 'New Generation'. One aspect deals with the emotional, social and intellectual well-being or the development of a healthy well centred personality and the other comprises various aspects with regard to healthy physical growth and development.

Both these areas should be dealt with in a comprehensive manner for nature adulthood. Parents need to avoid the pitfalls of trial-and-error method and thus doing the right thing the first time around so that these children grow up as capable and self-confident, ready to take on responsibility and any challenges to succeed in life.

- 2. New Gen Parents need to effectively communicate with the child, both verbally talking and listening, as well as non-verbally, with loving appropriate body language and behaviour
- 3. New Gen Parents need to implement few important age-appropriate rules or boundaries, consistently, firmly and lovingly, reinforcing approved behaviour in the child, instilling self control and with it willpower to overcome setbacks in life to achieve success.
- 4. New Gen Parents need to appreciate and praise the child's effort; it positively reinforces appropriate behaviour, builds up self confidence and self esteem.

- 5. New Gen Parents need to constructively criticize the child's inappropriate behaviour but to never demean or belittle the child.
- 6. New Gen Parents need to help develop in a child various age appropriate skills or hobbies thereby empowering him or her.
- 7. New Gen Parents need to motivate, set age appropriate goals for a child to achieve; Children need to be motivated to excel.
- 8. New Gen Parents need to demonstrate character values such as kindness, honesty, justice, compassion, empathy and other positive attributes so that the children emulate them, as they learn best by imitation.
- 9. New Gen Parents need to be effective role models, walk the talk and talk the walk; clearly defining right from wrong as so a child develops integrity and honesty and with it comes conscience and character.
- 10. New Gen Parents need to be proactive, taking initiative and nipping problems in the bud with empathy and understanding.
- 11. New Gen Parents need to maintain harmony and humour in the family to facilitate bonding and a sense of security.
- 12. New Gen Parents need to respect each child's unique individuality without comparing them to others.

The personality development is a complicated process, involving various aspects of physical, mental, emotional, intellectual, spiritual and social abilities in an individual in relation to the environment and prevailing cultural milieu. Hence all aspects are important and if any one of these aspects is neglected, the overall development of the child is affected.

Each stage of development is characterized by certain skills which the child must achieve if he or she is to proceed with confidence to the next stage. The highest degree of functional harmony is achievable when the problems of each stage are met and overcome in a systematic and appropriate manner.

One needs to remember that the successive personality gains which the child makes however are not established rigidly at a single time but continued to be reinforced or threatened throughout the individual's lifetime.

Children need to be motivated to excel. They are too young to understand the significance of persistence and hard work and fail to comprehend its implication in their later life. Parents need to firmly and lovingly implement set boundaries so that the child instils certain values, skills and character to bring out their full potential.

Every child is born a potential genius but it is the quality of environment and parenting 'nurture versus nature' that determines the ultimate intelligence and personality of the individual as nurture versus nature. For example, in this present age of instant gratification children want all the comforts of life without working towards acquiring them. Parents need to teach them how to earn their wants.

At times one may need to use coercive methods to inculcate a sense of responsibility in children but physical punishment may prove counterproductive. Instead children need a variety of support systems, which may include some reprimands but more encouragement or positive strokes to bring out the best in them.

Parenting starts even before a child is born. In Planned Parenthood, it is at the time of conception and the subsequent confirmation of pregnancy that the mother's job of parenting begins. Surprisingly parents are now more willing to turn to the marketplace for help once they have provided a strong baseline of activities that allow them to direct how care is given, protect their connections as parents and assert their role as the primary caregiver. As achieving this balance helps parents maintain their feeling of responsibility, control and intimacy, for example when deciding whether or not to hire someone to plan the child's birthday party, they expect the party planner to do things their way thus exercise their control and sense of responsibility.
